Session 5 - Romance with God

1. How are the romantic thoughts God shares in the Bible different from God's thoughts about us as Father or Lord or Friend? (*See Living Loved* pp. 61-62.)
2. Thinking about the romantic thoughts God shared with Katharine (about you), has God said or demonstrated a similar thought to you? If so, which one(s)? (*See Living Loved* pp. 63-72.)
3. What was the most surprising thing God said about his romantic feelings in this session? Why was it surprising?
4. Of all the things Katharine spoke to God about how being in love with him makes her feel, which one stood out to you the most? Why? (*See Living Loved* pp. 72-76.)
5. Katharine gave three reasons why oneness love has romance at its foundation (*Living Loved* pp. 76-77). In your own words, how does structuring a relationship with God around romance create a different dynamic than building on a different kind of love? What does romance do for a relationship that nothing else does?
